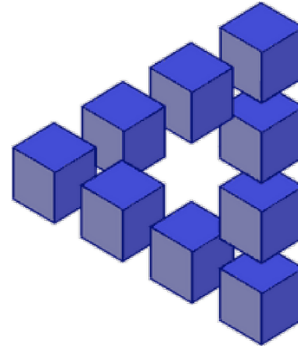


Mathematics

Initially, students follow a common course. The work is differentiated to suit the needs and abilities of the individual. During the first two terms a variety of topics is covered including:

- Algebra
- Angle Relationships
- Area
- Coordinates
- Fractions & Percentages
- Problem Solving Strategies
- Scales & Rounding



At the end of term 2, students are assessed and set into broad band ability groups in order for students to study at the most appropriate level.

Regular slots of time are given to mental maths and working on computer activities.
