

## Technical (Craft)

Craft classes in S2 spend half the session in each of the wood and metal disciplines. The timetable dictates whether the class starts with wood or metal, all classes changing over in late January.

The main focus of this course is "designing and making" with a design portfolio produced for each of the main projects in wood and metal.

Pupils will gain a knowledge of tools, process and materials (wood, metal & plastic). Safety, Environmental and recycling issues will also be covered..
